Independence Day -July 4



Inauguration Day - January 20



National Korean War Veterans Armistice Day – July 27



Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday – 3rd Monday in January



Labor Day – 1st Monday in September



Lincoln's Birthday – February 12



Constitution Day -September 17



Washington's Birthday -3rd Monday in February



Columbus Day - 2nd Monday in October



East Easter Sunday – Variable dates



Navy Day - October 27



Mother's Day - 2nd Sunday in May



Veterans Day -November 11



Armed Forces Day – 3rd Saturday in May



Thanksgiving Day - 4th Thursday in November



Memorial Day (half staff Until noon) – the last Monday in May



Christmas Day -December 25



Flag Day - June 14
