



Volunteer Dress Code Policy

Use good judgment with your appearance when you are volunteering and representing CRISTA. Senior Living residents are typically conservative and should be comfortable within their living environment. It is our commitment to provide a comfortable and appropriate atmosphere for our residents, guests, staff and volunteers. Our dress code for our volunteers is as follows:

- **Wear shoes with non-slip soles. No sandals or flip flops.**
- **Dangling earrings can be pulled or caught in clothing and should not be worn.**
- **Bracelets can hold grime and germs and should be removed.**
- **Low neck blouses, shirts, crop tops or half shirts may not be worn.**
- **T-shirts, or sweatshirts with slogans or advertisements should not be worn.**
- **Shorts, skirts may be worn if not be more than five inches above the knee.**
- **Tight fitting clothes may be offensive to the residents and conflict with the CRISTA message.**
- **Leggings may be worn if covered by a long, loose fitting top which covers to mid-thigh.**
- **No jeans with holes, badly frayed or stringy appearance**
- **Please make sure to cover any tattoos and body piercings.**
- **Think about hygiene and cleanliness with your clothing and appearance in general.**
